

CITY OF HARTWELL
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
April 27, 2018

PRESENT: Mayor Brandon Johnson, Councilmembers Arthur Craft, Billy Ethridge, Mike MacNabb, Tony Haynie, Tray Hicks, and Bill Griggs. Also present were City Manager David Aldrich, Assistant City Manager Jon Herschell, City Clerk Janet Fleming, Officer Dexter S. Blackwell, Representatives from the Press/Media..

The Hartwell City Council met in a special called meeting on Friday April 27, 2018 at 12:00 noon in the council chambers of city hall. Mayor Brandon Johnson called the meeting to order and stated the purpose of the meeting was to vote on allowing health insurance with BCBS of Georgia to expire at midnight on April 30, 2018 and to give an update on the status of health insurance. Other business included authorizing the City Manager and the Finance Officer to process checks for stipends for employees to assist with insurance premiums.

Councilman Haynie made a motion to allow the City's health insurance with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia to expire at midnight on April 30, 2018. Motion was seconded by Councilman Craft and Carried unanimously. 6-0

A motion was also made by Councilman Haynie and seconded by Councilman Hicks to authorize the City Manager and Finance Officer to cut checks for stipends for City employees to assist with insurance premiums. Motion carried unanimously. 6-0

There being no further business, a motion was made by Councilman Craft to adjourn the meeting at approximately 12:15 p.m. Motion was seconded by Councilman Haynie and carried unanimously. 6-0
